

- Masking is optional, however, the CDC recommends those who are not vaccinated to continue using them. Please understand, there will be no policing this, the recommendation is only for an FYI. The church property is to be a shame free zone. No one should be shamed for wearing a mask and no one should be shamed for not wearing a mask.
- There are no seating restrictions. Handshakes/hugs are permitted but people should remain respectful of other people's boundaries, how close they can get and whether or not a hug or handshake is welcome. (Sunday, I demonstrated the universal sign when someone doesn't want to shake hands or hug. And told them they should not be offended if someone does that. Again this is a no shame zone.)
- Congregational singing is allowed
- Live scripture readers are back.
- Children's time is back.
- Joys and concerns are back however they will not be repeated. If you do not hear it, please approach the speaker afterwards nurturing the relationship.
- Connection cards will return as a welcoming and useful tool for both regular and guest worshipers.
- Adult Sunday School will resume in person attendance this Sunday, in the Adult Sunday School room starting at 10.
- Coffee time/fellowship will be offered on the patio allowing for time to reconnect. It will be hosted in June by W.A.L.T, the Welcoming Aesthetic Landscape Team that was responsible for the Patio and Island, as well as planting and maintaining the landscape beds, cleaning the building and improving the drainage around the church.
